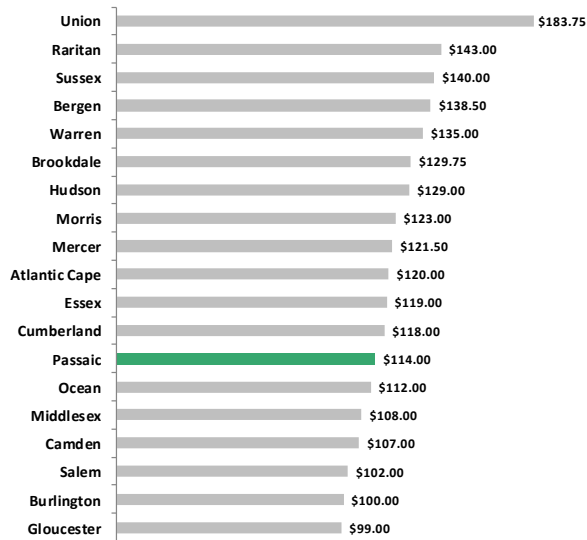
Financial Aid for First-time Full-time Students by Type, AY 2015-2016:

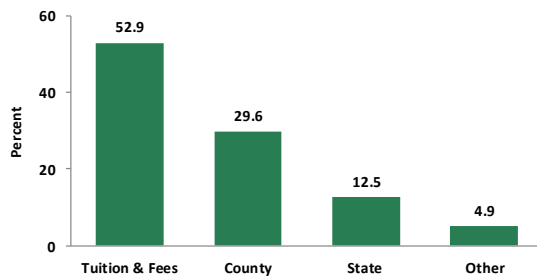
Per Credit In-District Tuition in NJ Community Colleges, AY 2016-2017

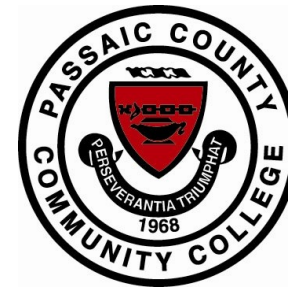

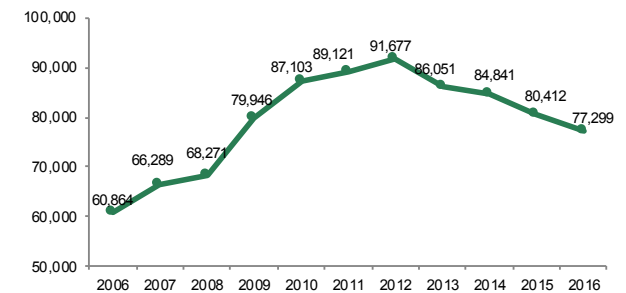

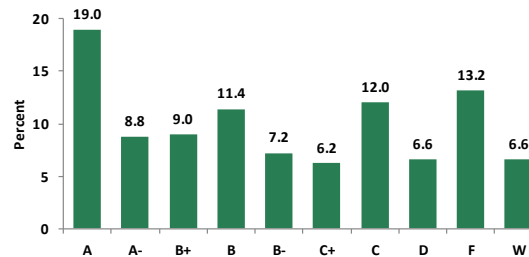

Overall Grade Distribution: Fall 2016



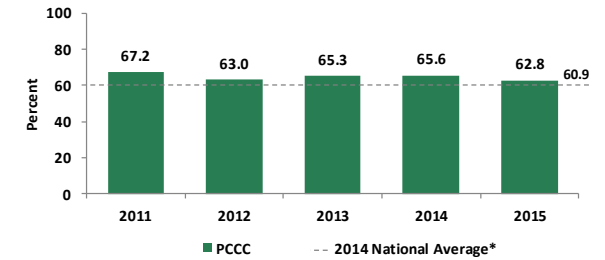

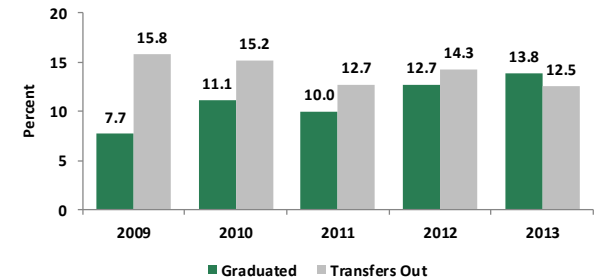
One Year Retention Rate for First-time Full-time Degree-Seeking Students: Fall 2011 - Fall 2015
