About the Exhibition and Artist

In celebration of Hispanic Heritage Month, the Passaic County Cultural and Heritage Council at Passaic County Community College is pleased to present *NIGHT OF WONDERS*, an exhibition of paintings and photographs by New Jersey artist **ANTHONY L. RODRIGUEZ**. Inspired by

Of Puerto Rican heritage, Rodriguez is a painter, photographer and exhibition designer whose atmospheric paintings and photographs reflect his interest in forgotten, out-of-the-way places. "Lonely, degraded, romantic and isolated places attract me because they make me feel comfortable and uncomfortable," says the artist who also likes the night with all the mysteries and inspiration it brings him.

Influenced by the painters Edward Hopper and Vincent Van Gogh and by film noir, Rodriguez transforms the images he captures with his camera into expressive paintings, visual narratives to be interpreted by viewers.

Anthony L. Rodriguez is currently Exhibition Designer/Photographer at the George Segal Gallery, Montclair State University. He received an M.F.A. in Painting and Photography from Montclair State University and a B.F.A. from Kean University. Rodriguez has received artist residencies from the Vermont Studio Center and I-Park Artist Enclave in Connecticut. He has exhibited his work at the Shore Institute of Contemporary Arts, Long Branch, NJ; Red Bank International Film Festival; P.P.O.W., New York City and other regional venues.
