Course Overview

The Certified Home Health Aide (CHHA) course is designed for individuals who are interested in making a difference in the lives of others by becoming a Home Health Aide. This course is required for individuals seeking a career as a Certified Home Health Aide. Students who successfully complete the course will be eligible to apply for certification through the New Jersey Board of Nursing. Students who are approved for certification are granted the title of Certified Home Health Aide (CHHA).
