### About the Exhibition

The Passaic County Cultural and Heritage Council at Passaic County Community College is pleased to honor Women's History Month with *Year 360*, an exhibition of drawings and sculpture by Barbara Wallace, a New Jersey artist known for her figurative works and innovative use of papier mâché. A sculptor trained in the traditional materials of clay, metal, stone and wood, Ms. Wallace often applies her techniques to unusual materials, such as layers of newspaper, cardboard, and glue.

Of her current work, the artist says, “Creating long-lasting sculpture from unlikely and somewhat ephemeral materials of yesterday’s news and this afternoon’s lunch is the crux of my artwork.”

In this exhibit, the papier mâché sculptures were painted to have the appearance of bronze. Several of these relief sculptures are shown with drawings, which are preliminary studies for the artworks. Wallace’s piece, *Year 360*, is a fine example of her work.

Ms. Wallace received her BFA in Painting from Pratt Institute in Brooklyn and her MFA in Sculpture from the University of Pennsylvania. She is currently an Adjunct Professor of Art at Kean University and Passaic County Community College, and has exhibited her work widely in New Jersey and New York galleries. Ms. Wallace was also selected to participate in the 2013 Emerge 11 at the Aljira Center for Contemporary Art in Newark, NJ.
