New Pathways to Teaching in New Jersey Stage I

A Certificate of Eligibility (CE) is required to take Stage I of the NPTNJ program. Stage I is a 60 hour course, 45 hours of instruction and 15 hours of classroom observation. Topics include basic instructional strategies, curriculum, theory, thinking skills, diversity issues, lesson planning, special needs for students, record keeping, and more.
