Applications can also be submitted by mail or fax.

- All applicants must have a high school transcript or GED sent to the Office of Admission. Although not required for admission to PCCC, if you have taken the SAT in the last five years, please feel free to submit your test scores. Scores may be used to exempt you from placement testing.
- Transfer students and college graduates must have official college transcripts sent to the Office of Admission prior to registration. An academic program must be selected in order for a transfer credit evaluation to be completed.
- Visiting students (students currently enrolled at another institution) should have written permission from their home school and will need a current college transcript in order to register for classes.
- Official transcripts should be sent **directly** to the Office of Admission at PCCC by the issuing institution.
- If you are sending your transcript electronically and are asked to provide an email address for delivery be sure to use the office of Admissions email admissions@pccc.edu.
- Social Security Number is required if you intend to apply for financial aid. Each student will be issued a student ID number once the application has been processed.
