INTRODUCTION TO TEACHING

Effective October 31, 2009, alternate route teacher candidates must take “Introduction to Teaching” in order to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility (CE), the first step towards Standard Certification.

This is a 24 hour course: 20 classroom hours and 4 observations hours. Course content includes: An Overview of the Teaching Profession, Classroom Management, Assessment Tools, Lesson Plans, Learning Strategies, Job Search Strategies for Teachers, Diversity in the Classroom, the Implementation of Technology, and Classroom Observations.
