About the Exhibition

In celebration of Hispanic Heritage, the Passaic County Cultural and Heritage Council at Passaic County Community College is pleased to present PASSAGES, an exhibition of photographs from the archives of the Inner City Ensemble (ICE), a non-profit youth performing arts based in Paterson.

Passages spans several decades and features images of ICE, founded in 1973. The exhibit includes photographs of the newly re-established ICE youth group. Nicholas Rodriguez, the company's Artistic Director and the exhibit curator, has selected photos that demonstrate the scope of the organization's performance and training history. ICE, originally founded by Ralph Gomez, and re-established by alumni and former staff in 2010, is committed to bringing dance and theatre training to underserved, at-risk Paterson youth.
