- 2. A check for **\$18.00** payable to PCCC must accompany submission (in the memo section of the check write "Poetry Contest"). Please note there is a \$55 "bounced check" fee for checks that are returned for insufficient funds.
- 3. Only **unpublished poems** may be submitted to the contest.
- 4. **Deadline: April 1, 2013** (postmark).
- 5. Winners will be announced upon receiving the judges' results in Summer 2013.
- 6. Contest entrants are asked not to call the college in reference to the contest. Winners will be notified by mail. Winners' names will also appear in newspaper announcements and on our website, www.pccc.edu/poetry. Please include SASE for list of winners.
