ABOUT THE ARTIST

PCCC welcomes Rosa Soy back for the second time as a Playwright-in-Residence. A native of Havana, Cuba, Ms. Soy is a multi-talented artist in several genres. She holds a BA in music and maintains a successful career as a composer, vocalist, and music director.

Ms. Soy has written numerous songs recorded on gold and platinum selling albums. She also collaborated on "*The Rose Slippers*," a musical theater piece that won third prize in the 2004 Jackie White National Memorial Children's theater competition, and is being adapted as a children's book.

In 2002, Ms. Soy received a "Meet the Composer" grant for a mixed-media project sponsored by the Tunnel Vision Writer's Project in Montclair, NJ.

Her plays *Venial Sins* and *Pigeons* were selected for the Samuel French festival in New York .

Ms. Soy recently completed her first full-length novel, *Guava Road*. She is currently working on additional writing projects and on a new theatrical piece based on the "goddess" theme.
