New Pathways to Teaching in New Jersey

Stage I

A Certificate of Eligibility (CE) is required to take Stage I of the NPTNJ program. Stage I is a 60 hour course, 45 instructional and 15 observation hours. Topics include basic instructional strategies, curriculum, theory, thinking skills, diversity issues, lesson planning, special needs for students with disabilities, recordkeeping, and more.

The following items must be provided to the Program Coordinator prior to registering for the course: A copy of your CE; 3 sealed transcripts; a copy of your Praxis II scores; a completed NPTNJ application.

Stage II

Completion of Stage I and employment as a contracted teacher in the area of your CE, either full-time or part-time. The Stage II program is a 140 hour course shaped by five interconnected themes: Planning and Preparation, Instructional Delivery, Classroom Environment, School Environment, and Professional Responsibilities.

You must provide a copy of your contract from the school or school district where you have been hired prior to registering for the program.
