### Associate in Science (A.S.) Degree in Homeland Security (Approved by the State of New Jersey)



Homeland Security is a fast-growing field in today's job market where well-trained specialists are needed to fill a wide variety of jobs in the U.S. Department of Homeland Security as well as with state, county, and local governments.

This new 60-credit degree program is designed to provide students with a broad view of Homeland Security issues and an understanding of the basic responsibilities of defending the United States. Areas of study include: **Investigative Function, Terrorism and Political Violence, Hazardous Materials, Forensic Science, Emergency Management and Reponse.**

Students will also gain a strong general education background including: writing, science, computer technology, social sciences, and more.
